This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

The school is directed to ensure that :

1	The total number of section of the school after upgradation, shall be restricted to 28 (As per prescribed dimension) out of which, not more than 1/3rd sections may be used to run Senior Secondary classes and further increase shall be subjected to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws.
2	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 28, after up gradation. The total number of sections taken together for classes XI and XII should not be more than 1/3 of total number of section allowed. Further, increase of section shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws and subject to the availability of room size of greater than 500 sq ft.
3	Only 1 CWSN toilet is seen in the supplementary video, which is not as per norms as it has no room for a wheel chair/walker to navigate. The school shall construct separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage ,including the floor number, as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS.
4	The school has overlaid a ramp on a staircase, which makes it steep and dangerous for CWSN to navigate. The school shall dismantle the same and construct a ramp as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board or install a lift and submit compliance within 3 months.
5	As per IC, all the labs need more equipment. They are seen with inappropriate furniture(desks and tables) Maths lab is reported to be under sized. Library is poorly stocked without proper seating area. No separate reading area for staff is seen. The school shall upgrade its labs and library as per SoPs issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS.
6	The school is seen to have no well developed outdoor sports area. The school shall upgrade its sports facilities as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS. Failure to submit compliance on the above mentioned points in the prescribed time may invite financial penalty against the school.
7	The school shall get all the mandatory certificates renewed periodically.

8	The school is directed not to remove the mandatory disclosure section from its website and the videography link of the inspection /infrastructure from YouTube.
9	The composite science lab is under equipped and looks temporarily arranged, with no work stations and utilities. The maths lab is designed for primary level students only with inappropriate furniture and equipment. The school shall upgrade the composite science lab and maths lab as per SoPs issued by the Board and submit compliance within 3 months on SARAS. Failure to submit compliance in respect of above mentioned points within the prescribed time, shall invite financial penalty against the school.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

- The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- The School is required to apply on online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
- The school to renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.

“The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate and Building safety certificate during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms”.
